Parent Information (please keep for reference)

1. To be eligible for Driver Education, a student must be **14 years old to be able to complete the driving experience**. Student's 14th birthday must be NO later than July 1. Upon completion of the class the student will receive a signed certificate of completion. The certificate is signed by the instructor when the student has completed the 30 hours of classroom time and six hours of drive time. Please keep a copy of this certificate for your car insurance agent.
2. The Driver Education course is offered to students in grades 7 – 12 and adults. Session Two is held at 6:00 pm to better serve track students. If you need to be gone for a track meet, student MUST visit with the instructor. Class size is limited so please register early. Payment should accompany registration form.
3. Licensing and insurance information:
 - A. Driver Education students, at the time of the driving test, may take the test for licensing purposes. This certificate is given to the student upon successfully completing the course informs the driving examiner that the student has combined the requirements for the South Dakota driver license testing program. Additional state fees and tests are then required prior to the issuance of a license.
 - B. If Driver Education is to be used applying for insurance reductions, see your insurance agent for proper information.

4. Driver Education attendance and drop policy:
 - A. Full refund of tuition less \$20.00 will be given between the time of registration and TWO WORKING DAYS prior to the first day of class. No full or partial refunds will be given after that deadline.
 - B. Students must attend ALL sessions or make them up. Make up will be arranged by the teacher, but will be extremely difficult, so please do your best not to miss class.
5. Actual driving time (six hours per student) will be arranged between student and instructor and will be completed by the end of July. Students must be 14 years of age to drive.
